We conducted Indrani G.K competition on 18th July in memory of Late Indrani Banerjee.


The competition took place in Nai Roshni and Bhavishya Academy. Students were awarded cash prizes by Mr. Banerjee

# Mango Day





## Independence Day celebration





# Teacher's Day Celebration (on 04 & 5th Sept-23)





# HOLI CELEBRATION



Mother's Day serves as a poignant reminder to honour the cherished connection between mothers and their children.


Mothers hold an irreplaceable role in our lives, shaping, guiding, and inspiring us with their unconditional love and unwavering support.
